

DigiMed Bayern Symposium 2019

Translational medicine in the digital age



The first DigiMed Bayern Symposium took place at the German Heart Centre Munich on November 6. The event highlighted the broad spectrum of digital medicine in various sessions: from the ethical and legally responsible handling of personal patient data via digitization in clinical research to the ecosystem of digital health.

More than 150 participants discussed with national and international trendsetters the opportunities of digitization in medicine - for patients, the healthcare system and the economy.

Melanie Huml, Bavaria's Minister of Health, emphasized the importance of the lighthouse project *DigiMed Bayern* for P4 medicine, which is funded with 22,5 million euros by the State of Bavaria. She particularly sees a great potential of digital medicine for the benefit of the patient.

The next DigiMed Bayern Symposium is planned for the end of 2020.
